Air Force pilots new solar power storage system, a component of the new Advanced Energy Storage and Management System (AESM) spearheaded by the Air Force Research Laboratory Power Technology Office. The goal is to demonstrate that solar power can add to a seamless energy management system for a sensitive, high-demand facility.
