, on a potential role of biofuels in a military's energy mix, and a military's potential role in biofuels development. According to Luft, "With respect to biofuels, the only role I see for the military is in the testing and certification of fuels to make sure they can be used should they prove economically viable. What I don't want to see from the military is mass adoption of fuels that are in many cases much more expensive – [as] this would come at the expense of other needs."
