El Paso Electric is building a 20 MW solar farm at Fort Bliss in Texas; a major step toward making the installation net zero – producing as much energy as it consumes. The solar farm is expected to be completed in 2015. Fort Bliss is already home to the U.S. Army's second-largest, 1.4 MW solar array. It has also installed a 13.4 MW rooftop solar on housing posts.
